- Collecting information from Pecan Farmers. The inquiry covers Improved Varieties and Native.
 We are asking...
 - o Pecan Acreage 2024
 - Improved Acres: if they don't know acres but know number of trees, please comment number of trees
 - Native Acres: if they don't know acres but know number of trees, please comment number of trees or put in IC 345
 - Pecan Production 2024
 - You should expect farmers to provide production/pounds harvested. If no production, enter 0 (zero). If they do not know, enter Don't Know.
 - If production is 0 (zero), enter a comment.
 - Pecan Sold
 - Average price per pound?

OR

- Total dollars received?
- Has the total 2024 pecan crop been marketed (Yes or No)

Definitions:

- Improved Varieties:
 - These trees are the result of careful grafting and budding.
 - Usually planted in managed, cultivated groves.
 - Shell is much thinner than that of the seedling and consequently its meat yield is normally higher.
- Native Varieties:
 - o Grow wild, usually unattended and not cultivated.
 - Nut is typically smaller but flavor and full firm meat make it especially adaptable for commercial uses.
- Total Pecan Acres = Improved Pecan Acres + Native Pecan Acres
 - Survey does not ask for total pecan acres, instead it just asks for improved acres and native acres
- Bearing:
 - Trees of "Bearing" age are old enough to produce nuts
 - o Total Improved Acres must be greater than or equal to Improved Bearing Acres
 - o Total Native Acres must be greater than or equal to Native Bearing Acres
 - Total Acres >= Bearing Acres

ALERT!

- If an operator says they have no pecans, please clarify if they meant they have no pecans ACRES/TREES or no pecan PRODUCTION. Some ops will say they have no pecan acreage when they have pecan trees, just no pecan production
- It is okay if they have 0 production, if able please comment to verify (i.e. drought, op said bad year, etc.)
